b. Article 34 Addition to Division Placement Criteria

The Division Placement Committee will be allowed to use the following criteria to help determine which schools move up or down a division when there are multiple teams be considered for movement.

1. Strength of Schedule
2. Record vs. Common Opponents
3. Record vs. Opponents in the same Division of Higher

c. Proposed Criteria for Play-Off Seeding for Tennis, Water Polo, Volleyball, Soccer, Baseball and Softball

The process will remain as currently done with each criteria being worth one point.

1. Coaches Mandatory Rankings
2. Head to Head
3. Overall Record
4. Record vs. Common Opponents
5. Maxpreps Strength of Schedule
6. Place in Same League
7. MaxPreps Rankings

Current criteria s not balanced. Currently Place in Same Tournament and Head to Head can count as 2 points.

If Maxpreps does not have a Strength of Schedule, that Criteria Will Not be Used.

Coaches Mandatory Rankings will be used as a starting point. If a coach does not turn in their division rankings, **THEY WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR A SEEDED PLACE IN THE BRACKET.**

VIII. CIF Central Section Action Items

- a. Hi-Lo Desert League request to join the Central Section with a permanent travel.

The Hi-Lo Desert League is proposing that they are allowed to join the Central Section with a permanent travel restriction. Section staff will attempt to match up their schools in the play-offs whenever possible with the High Desert League. The committee will not disrupt the integrity of the bracket to achieve this.
